Putrajaya: Known for its blend of modern architecture and nature, students will visit the Putra Mosque and Putrajaya Lake, exploring Malaysia's administrative capital and its carefully planned layout.

Malacca: A UNESCO World Heritage Site, Malacca offers insights into Malaysia's colonial past. Visits to A Famosa and St. Paul's Church reveal the historical influence of Portuguese and Dutch settlements.

Ipoh: Known for its colonial architecture, charming old town, and local delicacies, Ipoh introduces students to Perak's unique heritage. Highlights include Ipoh's historic buildings, reflecting a blend of history and local culture.

Gua Tempurung: This large limestone cave system near Ipoh provides students with an adventure into Malaysia's natural landscape. Known for its impressive stalactites and stalagmites, Gua Tempurung offers a hands-on experience of Malaysia's geological wonders.

Penang: In Penang, students explore the multicultural essence of George Town, a UNESCO site known for its colorful street art, traditional architecture, and culinary diversity.



This itinerary gives students a well-rounded experience of Malaysia's capital cities, colonial heritage, and natural landscapes, deepening their understanding of the country's cultural diversity and natural beauty.
