Eligibility Criteria

- Citizen of Malaysia
- Existing TAR UMT Bachelor Degree / Diploma student with a minimum CGPA of 3.0000; New Diploma students with at least 5As in SPM*
- Financially needy with total monthly income of parents / guardian of RM5000 and below

*Note:

- Existing TAR UMT students submit the latest Diploma / Degree overall results.
- New Diploma students submit the SPM results.
- New Degree students from STPM / UEC / A-Level / Foundation submit the relevant overall final results.

Number of Scholarship Awards:

2 awards at a time

Value of Scholarship

- University fees as per student bill (excluding fees for dual award/professional programmes, special projects, field trips, external accreditation, study abroad or re-sit/repeat of subjects).
- The tenure of the scholarship is only for the standard/normal programme duration.

Terms & Conditions

- During the programme of study, the scholarship recipient is not allowed to hold concurrently any other forms of financial assistance, except for the PTPTN loan.
- The recipient's eligibility will be reviewed on a yearly basis, and any extensions for a successive year will be granted at the absolute discretion of LC1010 Club Malaysia subject to the satisfactory academic performance and conduct.
- The recipient is required to maintain a minimum CGPA of 3.0000 every semester.
- The recipient is required to join <u>LC1010 CLUB MALAYSIA</u> as a student member and will be involved in at least one (1) LC1010 Club Malaysia's event per year as an organizing committee / helper, provided this shall not jeopardise the recipient's studies.
- No internship placement or service bond is attached.
- The recipient shall not change his/her programme of studies unless with written permission from LC1010.
- Dropping subject(s) is not permitted as it may lead to extension of the programme duration and delay in graduation.
- The scholarship award will be disbursed by offsetting the university fee as per student bill.
- Scholarship recipients may be required to reimburse the scholarship award amount received up to the date of termination / withdrawal / suspension, in case of termination / withdrawal / suspension from TAR UMT.
